SUBJECT: IMPORTANT – MODIFICATIONS IN CANADIAN ENERGY EFFICIENCY REGULATIONS FOR WATER HEATERS

This bulletin is to inform you of a change in Canada that will limit the transfer of certain water heater models from one province to another as of June 28th, 2017. It is therefore important to verify your inventory and requirements as some of the products described in the appendix (see page 2) may not be shipped to you after this date and will not be lawfully transited in any way from one province to another. The new models replacing them will be within regulations.

The reason behind this is that a major change occurred last December when **NRCan** (Natural Resources Canada) adopted **Amendment 13** which will come into effect on June 28th, 2017. As explained above, this standard controls and limits the transfer of products from one province to another. **Amendment 13** covers, amongst other things, the efficiency of gas water heaters ($\leq 75,000$ Btu/h, 20 to 100 US gallons) and oil water heaters ($\leq 105,000$ Btu/h, 20 to 100 US gallons). However, it does not apply if the product is manufactured and sold in the same province. In this case, only the provincial regulation is applicable.

It is important to understand that as of June 28th we will be unable to ship certain water heater models from our facilities to other provinces that will no longer meet the new energy efficiency standards imposed by Amendment 13.

More precisely, to order the few models that will no longer meet these new standards, we invite you to validate, without delay, your inventory and the needs to be filled. Once done, please contact your sales representative or our Order Desk department (1-800-363-9354, option 2) to confirm the availability of the products and ensure delivery possibilities before the deadline. After this date, only the replacement models can be shipped.

In order to assist you in your planning, you will find enclosed a list of water heater models that we will no longer be able to ship as well as their replacement model.
