

## Gas Water Heaters Approved for High Altitude

Residential gas water heaters that are labelled “HIGH ALTITUDE” on the cardboard box (Red label) are certified to be used at Normal **AND** High Altitude or from 0 to 4,500 ft (1,372 m) over sea level.

Looking at the rating plate on the water heater, you will see under “Altitude”, the specific altitude for which the water heater has been certified. [ 0 – 2,000’ ] (610 m) means that the water heater is certified for Normal Altitude only and [ 0 – 4,500’ ] (1,372 m) means that the water heater is certified for Normal **AND** High Altitude.
