Low Lead Content

The Reduction of Lead in Drinking Water Act is an amendment to Section 1417 of the United States Safe Drinking Water Act. This amendment, which took effect January 4, 2014, restricts wetted surfaces of pipes, pipe fittings, plumbing fittings, and fixtures to not more than a weighted average of 0.25% lead. Since water heaters are part of a system that conveys water for human consumption, they are also subject to the lead regulation.

Currently, all products manufactured by Giant Factories inc. are certified in Canada and United States through Canadian Standard Association (CSA) in accordance with NSF/ANSI 372 to comply with the weighted average of 0.25% lead. Therefore, products manufactured by Giant comply with the Reduction of Lead in Drinking Water Act.
